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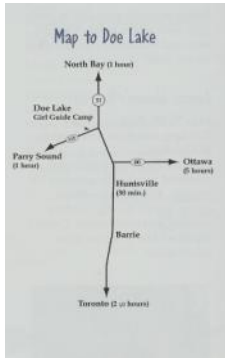

Welcome to Doe Lake Camp

Winter Camping on Residential Sites



GENERAL INFORMATION: Doe Lake Camp, established in 1948, is owned and operated by Girl Guides of Canada, Ontario Council. It is located 25 minutes north of Huntsville in the Near North Region. Doe Lake Camp consists of 800 acres on Hwy. #518 off Hwy. #11, on the south shore of Doe Lake.

Doe Lake Camp residential camping is available for Unit and Group camping/conferences, from January 15th to June 15th and from September 3rd to December 20th, 2010. Tenting sites are available May 7th to June 20th and September 3rd to October 31st, 2010. The campsites are reserved during the summer season for composite Girl Guide Camping programs, however there are some sites that may be available for non-composite camping. There are numerous established hiking trails within the boundary of the camp property. The Cross Canada Trail is located $\frac{1}{2}$ km. from the outer boundary of the camp.

ACCOMMODATION (Residential): There are four sites available for residential camping. All have electricity, heat, hot and cold water, flush toilets, showers and equipped kitchens. **(Campers must bring their own ditty bags.)** Toilet paper, javex, dish detergent, and dish towels are all provided. The number of persons who can be accommodated in individual buildings varies. These details are described below. All residential sites are centrally located on the northeast side of the camp. Rental cost for these facilities is **\$17.00 per person/night** with a 2-night minimum. Please see the minimum capacity for each building. All weekend camping on these sites is self-catered. Catering information, for those who want to make arrangements for this service, is available from the booking clerk.

The Chalet



Two-storey building accommodating **40 people (minimum 20 people)**; 5 rooms with 2 sets of bunks on each level; 2 multi-purpose rooms, one on each level; fireplace and outdoor patio area; main floor accessibility; newly equipped kitchen; five minute walk to the parking lot. Recommended maximum of 20 people if you are cooking/ eating in this lodge. **(Campers must bring their own ditty bags.)** Rate is **\$17.00 per person/per night**. Minimum flat rate is **\$340/night**.

Chater House



Bungalow near the waterfront with wrap-around deck, **accommodation for 20 persons (minimum of 10 persons)** in 4 rooms with 2 sets of bunks in each and 2 rooms with 2 beds in each; Recommended maximum of 12 people if you are cooking/ eating in this lodge; newly equipped kitchen; main floor multi-purpose room with fireplace and walkout; multi-purpose room with walkout, in the basement; barrier-free access to the main floor; one minute walk to the parking lot. **(Campers should bring their own ditty bags.)** Rate is **\$17.00 per person/per night**. Minimum flat rate is **\$170/night**.

Opechee



Accommodates **40 persons (minimum of 20)** in 10 rooms with 2 sets of bunks in each; walk-in refrigeration but no freezer; fully equipped kitchen including dishes; large multi-purpose room with fireplace; main floor accessibility; 8 minute walk to main parking lot. **Rate is \$17.00 per person/per night. Minimum flat rate is \$340/night.**

Wilson House



Three-storey structure accommodating **40 persons (minimum of 20)**, in 10 rooms with 2 sets of bunks in each, all on the main (middle) floor; large multi-purpose rooms on the floor above and on the lower floor; kitchen on the lower level; fireplace is not to be used; located adjacent to the parking lot. Recommended maximum of 30 people if

you are doing your own cooking. **(Campers must bring their own ditty bags.)**

Rate is \$17.00 per person/per night. Minimum flat rate is \$340/night.



ACCOMMODATION (Tenting): Available May 1st. There are **seven tenting sites** available. One tenting campsite is located on the north side of Highway 518 (road to Sprucedale) and others are across the road from the main camp. Each has a site hut equipped with electricity, hot and cold running water, stove/oven, fridge, dishwashing sink and gathering area. There is also access to the two comfort stations, one on the north side and one of the south side of the camp. Each is equipped with barrier-free access, electricity, hot and cold running water, 6 temperature-controlled showers, six flush toilets and 8 wash basins.

****Campers renting any of the marked tenting sites must bring their own tents and all equipment with them. Tents are provided on other sites but the group is responsible for bringing their own cooking gear.**



Birch Cliff is the only tenting site on the north side of the camp. The **maximum number of campers on this site is 36 (minimum 18)**. There is one outdoor quad privy on site. It is a 3-5 minute walk to the North Comfort Station for hot showers and flush toilets. There are three tents accommodating 8 persons each and one tent for 6 people. All are on platforms. **Rate is \$7.00 per person/per night. Minimum flat rate is \$126/night.**



****Bella Coola** is located on the south side of the camp and is a secluded site set off by itself. The **maximum number of campers on this site is 36 (minimum 20)**. There is one outdoor quad privy on site or a 5 minute walk takes campers to the South Comfort Station. There are **no tent platforms** on this site. **Rate is \$5.50 per person/per night. Minimum flat rate is \$88/night.**

****Little Eye** is a site set off by itself on the south side of the camp. The capacity of Little Eye is **24 campers (minimum 12)**. There is one outdoor quad privy or campers can take a 5 minute walk to the South Comfort station to use facilities there. There are **no tent platforms** on this site. **Rate is \$5.50 per person/per night. Minimum flat rate is \$66/night.**



Ashgrove, Good Neighbours, Olympia and Wagona sites are located in



close proximity to one another, making this an ideal location for group camping. Each site has a **maximum of 38 campers and a minimum of 20**. There is an outdoor, quad privy with easy access to the South Comfort Station. Each is equipped with 4 tents on platforms, accommodating 8 campers each and one tent for 6 people.



Olympia and Ashgrove have a shelter seating 40 people at picnic tables. **Rate is \$7 per person/per night. Minimum flat rate is \$140/night.**

Other Facilities:

The Longhouse

A large, indoor, multipurpose building (large gymnasium); hot and cold running water; indoor toilet facilities; fridge and stove; (no kitchen cookware) ;wheelchair accessibility.



The Lodge

Building is equipped with a commercial kitchen; dining room seats 150 for meals and 200 in a lecture-style setting. It is available for day use (tables and chairs) **but this does not include use of the kitchen**. Special arrangements for kitchen must be made through the Property Manager.



Rental is a flat rate of \$100. per day.

Important Information for Spring/Fall Campers at Doe Lake

1. In case of emergency, instructions to the nearest emergency facility are posted in each building. Emergency vehicles are the responsibility of the rental group.
2. Health forms, accident/incident reports, Safe Guide Forms (as applicable) and first aid kits are the responsibility of the rental group.
3. Doe Lake Staff may not be on site on the weekends. In the event of a facility problem, there is a staff person on call. The pager number of the staff person is posted by the telephone. Please call this number before calling any other personnel.

The following numbers can be provided to the emergency contact. It is important that callers are aware of the extension number in order to access your building. No outgoing calls can be made from these sites. There is improved cell phone reception at the camp but it is not 100% reliable. Local, emergency and toll-free calls may be made from your building. You will be billed for any telephone charges. All calls may also be made from the payphone on the side of the Lodge in the main parking lot. In the event of a power outage, the camp phones will not work.
