

APPENDIX - SAMPLE ITINERARY FOR A TRIP TO ENGLAND

“History of Guiding Tour” - England

Day 1 - Toronto

- Depart from Ottawa International Airport, 11:40 p.m. Flight to Gatwick Airport.

Day 2 - London

- Arrive 11:00 a.m. at Gatwick Airport
- Transfer to B-P House in London
- Remainder of day for rest and orientation

Day 3 - London

- Take a “Get Acquainted” tour of London in the a.m.
- Stop at the Tower of London
- Visit Olave Centre and Pax Lodge in the afternoon
- In the evening participate in an organized walking tour

Day 4 - London

- Changing of the Guards ceremony, from within the grounds of Buckingham Palace (prearranged)
- Visit Girl Guide Shop on Buckingham Palace Road
- Free time after lunch
- After supper attend Madame Toussaud’s “Rock Circus”

Day 5 - London to Foxlease

- Check out of B-P House
- Travel to Foxlease, stopping enroute to purchase groceries required for stay at the “Coach House”. (A fully equipped self-catering flat on the grounds of Foxlease)
- Remainder of day for unpacking and settling in

Day 6 - Foxlease “Canada Day”

- Attend local church service, if possible, locate the church where Lord and Lady B-P were married
- Meet up with our Guiding Pen-pals, invite them to join us on a “Canada Day Picnic” which we will provide
- Hold a “Campfire” and sing Canadian songs, etc.
- Supper in a restaurant in Lyndhurst

Day 7 - Foxlease

- Tour the coastal area, visit Poole, Swansea, Bournemouth and ferry over to Brownsea Island for lunch
- Run our toes through the stones on the beach
- Drive past “Pax Hill”, Lord and Lady B-P’s Hampshire residence on the way home
- Stop for supper on the way home, free time for the rest of the evening

Day 8 - Foxlease

- Visit Stonehenge and Winchester
- Try and locate a brass rubbing centre
- In Winchester visit the Cathedral, King Arthur’s Round Table and do some shopping
- After supper meet up with our Guiding friends for an evening of archery, abseiling and cookery, at a local Boy Scout Camp

APPENDIX - SAMPLE ITINERARY FOR A TRIP TO ENGLAND (CONT'D.)

Day 9 - Foxlease

- Public transport to point of departure for either the ferry or hydrofoil to the Isle of Wight
- Spend the day sightseeing on the Isle of Wight
- Free time upon return to Foxlease

Day 10 - Foxlease

- Spend the morning in Portsmouth, touring the HMS Victory and the HMS Mary Rose
- In the afternoon attend a proper British "High Tea" at the Wessex Hotel in Winchester
- Back to Foxlease to pack and clean up

Day 11 - Foxlease to London

- Check out of Foxlease and return to London
- Stop in Windsor to tour the castle on the way
- Check into Pax Lodge (if ready) or B-P House
- Evening plans open for discussion

Day 12 - London

- Free time for shopping and sightseeing in two groups
- "Big Night Out" dinner and "Phantom of the Opera"

Day 13 - London

- Day tour to Stratford
- Spend the day touring Shakespeare historical town
- Return to pack up for early departure

Day 14 - London

- Check out of "Pax Lodge" or B-P House
- Travel to Gatwick airport for 12.25 p.m. departure
- Arrive back in Ottawa at 2:50 p.m.

Note: Retaining the services of "Angela Coach Tours" (or other reputable supplier) who will provide you with a 19-seater coach and driver for the duration of the trip, except for a few days where you can use local transportation.
