 - Now get in the water and go surfing (pretend) have water fights.. This was so much fun.
- 7. Craft
 - Cut out flowers from felt, hole punch the centre of them. Thread them on to yarn and space them out with long beads.
 - One flower then long bead repeat. Tie end together to make Lei.
- 8. For supper have a luau with a Hula show.
 - Let each patrol make up their own Hula dance using Hawaiian music the theme from the "LILO AND STICH" movie was very popular with our girls.
 - They wore grass skirts we made from big black garbage bags with bathing suits.
 - For supper we had, Mi Tie's (virgin of course), chicken with pineapple and other Hawaiian foods. Use your imagination
 - The dinner show was very entertaining......DON'T FORGET YOUR CAMERA.
- 9. OUTSIDE:
 - We still went tobogganing, snow shoeing, hike to the frozen lake; we had a snowball fight.
 - We also did wood burning as a craft.
