

Saskatchewan Camping Outdoor Challenge 2024

The challenge is split up by branch, to reflect the growth of camping skills that happens from year to year. If you are a multi-branch unit, you may choose to follow the criteria for whichever branch you want or make up your own mixture using activities from each branch as appropriate.

Crests are limited – we will announce when we are running out! **This challenge is limited to Saskatchewan units.**

Remember to practice Leave No Trace practices at camp – for example, if you are creating shelters, make sure you use only fallen branches/logs and you put materials back where you found them.
